KySEA Mission

The **Kentucky Sustainable Energy Alliance** works to promote clean, sustainable and affordable energy solutions for Kentucky. We believe bold action is needed to reduce the risks to Kentucky's families and businesses from the related threats of climate change, environmental degradation, and rising energy costs. We seek sustainable energy policies that will simultaneously address the goals of job creation and entrepreneurship; public health, climate and environmental protection; and poverty reduction and community development. Our broad based coalition has come together to develop the ideas, resources, public understanding and political support necessary to advance solutions that can help all Kentuckians save money and energy, especially those who are most vulnerable to rising costs and rapidly changing energy conditions.

KySEA Policy Principles

We believe that energy policies should:

- **Make improving energy efficiency Kentucky's top energy priority.** (Public policies should include incentives and requirements to increase investment in energy efficiency by utilities, residents, businesses, and the public sector and to make energy efficiency improvements affordable for all.)
- **Promote the development of clean, renewable energy** from solar, wind, hydro and low-impact biomass, and increase the share of our overall energy mix that comes from these sources.
- **Create new jobs and opportunities for Kentuckians**, including a just transition for coal-affected communities and workers.
- **Enable all Kentucky residents and businesses to take advantage of energy efficiency and renewable energy solutions.**

While the alliance is likely to take positions on specific energy policies in the future, those decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis by the participating organizations.
